DAVID J. AND BARBARA (SCHULTZ) LICHTI FAMILY

David J. Lichti was born in 1870 and moved from Lot #9, Con. II to Lot #6, Con. III (West Section, Wellesley Township) at the age of five, with his parents Joseph B. and Catherine Lichti. He was only eleven years old when the family lost their father in 1881. However, his oldest brother, Christian, was already 22. Catherine and the family continued to farm until 1895 when the 200-acre farm was divided. David purchased the east half, with a laneway going in from the sideroad, while his brother Rudy got possession of the west half and the laneway going in from the Third Line. Each one developed a complete set of farm buildings only a short distance from each other.

Catherine. She occupied these rooms for many years.

David was ordained a deacon in the Mapleview Amish Mennonite congregation on May 13, 1923 and served until his death in 1936 at the age of 66. David lived to be somewhat older than his brother Rudy and his father Joseph B. Lichti. His son Samuel who succeeded him on the farm died at age 42 and grandson Orval at age 50 -- all of heart problems. Orval again came into possession of the original 200 acres. His son Richard now occupies the Lichty farm. The sixth generation, Bradley Richard, was born to Richard and Mary (McTavish) Lichty in 1981.

David married Barbara Schultz in 1894. She was the daughter of John and Barbara Schultz. David added an apartment to his house for his mother,

NANCY LICHTI AND DANIEL SCHMIDT FAMILY

The eighth child of Joseph B. and Catherine Lichti was given the name Anna according to the family Bible. However, she was known to her family and friends as "Nancy."

In 1893 Nancy married Daniel B. O. Schmidt, son of Jacob Schmidt and Barbara Boshart. The Jacob Schmidt family used two initials, the first two letters of their mother's name -- "B.O." -- to distinguish them from other Schmidts in the community.

Nancy and Daniel lived at a number of places, including Wellesley, Poole and Milverton. Daniel had more than one occupation. They lived for some time at the cider mill in Wellesley and made apple butter. Daniel was also a mechanic and had a shop above the mill. While living in Milverton he worked for Ebersol who manufactured self-feeders for threshing machines.

Nancy and Daniel are buried in the cemetery adjoining the Mapleview Mennonite church.

Moses was probably the last of the Joseph B. and Catherine Lichti children to be born on Lot #9, Con. II, West Section, Wellesley Township. He was only 2½ years old when the family moved to Lot #6, Con. III.

Moses was the last of the Joseph B. Lichti family to marry. In 1905 he married Anna Lichti, a foster daughter of Christian Z. Lichti.

Moses and Anna farmed on the south half of Lot #7, Con. II where their four oldest children were born. In 1921 or 22 they moved to New York. They had a farm near Clarence Center and later a gravel trucking business.

Moses and Anna were members of the Conservative Amish Mennonite Church. Moses died in 1937 at the age of 64, but Anna lived to be 89. They are buried in the County Line cemetery, Alden, New York.

Barbara was only five years old when her father died. However, she had a host of older brothers and sisters, and probably did not lack for love and attention.

In 1900, Barbara married Jacob S. Erb, the son of John S. Erb and Mary Schwartzentruber. The Erb family lived on Lot #5, across the road from the Lichti's. Barbara and Jacob had gone to school together and were no strangers to each other. Barbara's older sister, Catherine, had married John Gascho, who was half brother to Jacob S. Erb.

Jacob and Barbara settled on the north half of Lot #6, Con. II, beside Jacob's parents and across the road from Barbara's family. Here they raised six children. One died in infancy. Only two are living at this time -- Mary and John.

The youngest son, John L. Erb, remained on the home farm. His son Larry now occupies the farm. Samuel was located on Lot #7, beside John L.

Barbara and Jacob were members of the Mapleview Amish Mennonite congregation and are buried in the church cemetery.

Dorothy (Erb) Yantzi reported how much they treasured the dishes they would receive from Grandmother Barbara at Christmas time.

We are indebted to John L. Erb for much of the information on the entire Lichti family

MARY LICHTI AND SOLOMON LEIS FAMILY

Mary Lichti, the eleventh and youngest child of Joseph B. and Catherine Lichti, was born in 1878. Since she was only three years old at the death of her father, she probably could not remember him. However, her older brothers and sisters probably showered her with love and attention.

In 1897 Mary married Solomon Leis, son of Joseph K. Leis and Catherine Roth. Solomon's grandmother, Magdalena (Jantzi) Kennel, was a sister to Mary's grandfather, Joseph Jantzi; so Mary and Solomon were second cousins.

The following is adapted from a presentation given at a family reunion in September, 1980, by Dorothy (Swartzentruber) Sauder:

"This is the story of Solomon and Mary Leis -- parents, grandparents, great grandparents, and great great grandparents to those found in the following pages. If you wonder why we appear in a Jantzi genealogy, it's because Granma's mother was a Jantzi. She married a Lichti and that's why Granma was Mary Lichti, the youngest child in a rather large family.

Granpa was born on December 31, 1876, on a farm on the road which skirts the south end of Wellesley. The house is no longer there. Granma was born on April 16, 1878 on the 3rd line on the old Lichti homestead, now owned by Orval Lichty's son, Richard.

When they were first married, they worked for Granpa's father, Joseph Leis, who was a widower at that time. When he married again, he arranged for Granpa and Granma to live on his farm on the 5th line. When Granpa's brother, Rudy, was married, he was put on the same farm and the two couples lived together for some time.

From there, Granpa and Granma moved to Baden where Granpa drove a cream wagon and Granma tried to get used to town living. Ada and Eddie were born in Baden. Allen, the oldest, was born on Great Granpa's farm and Lizzie, Nancy, and my mother, Katie, were born on the 5th-line farm.

Somewhere around 1908, they got the wanderlust and moved to Canboro Township in Haldimand County. A new settlement was getting under way

there and Granpa went on a scouting trip with some other new settlers to see the land he bought. Then he came home and moved the family by train. From the train, wagons transported their belongings to their new home. Roads were not paved and Mom (Katie) remembers how muddy they were. They settled on a 50-acre farm. Harvey was born in Canboro.

I'm not sure how long they lived in Canboro and when they moved back -- again by train. Granpa settled the family in a temporary home near Berlett's Corners while he looked around for a farm. A few months later they moved onto the 50-acre farm between Josephsburg and Berlett's Corners. Emma Lena was born there.

The last of Granpa's farms was a 100-acre one near Bamberg on the Hesson Road. From here the children one by one left home and eventually Granpa and Granma retired in Wellesley. The last years of their lives they made their home with my parents (Katie and Edwin Swartzentruber) in New Hamburg, and Mom looked after them until the end.

The years I remember best are when Granpa and Granma lived in the little house in Wellesley. Here Vanita grew up and there all of us grandchildren spent many happy days. There were many times when everyone went home to Granpa's and that included all the sons and daughters, their spouses and children. How did Granma manage to feed all of us before the days of the potluck?

I remember Granma's flower gardens and her coffee cake. I remember Granpa's workshop and how particular he was about his tools and the work he did there.

Granma died on June 19, 1959 and Granpa died on August 14, 1964. They left us a legacy of honest work, sacrificial love and deep faith in God. Their faith rested on the salvation that they found in Jesus and they held on to that faith to the end. Today their children and grandchildren have reason to be thankful for the wonderful memories we may cherish and for the example that they left for us."

All of Mary and Solomon's nine children are living at the time of this writing except Allen and Edward. Mary and Solomon were members of the Mapleview Amish Mennonite congregation and are buried in the cemetery adjoining the church.

BARBARA JANTZI AND JACOB SCHWEITZER FAMILY

Barbara Jantzi, second daughter of Joseph and Catherine Jantzi, was born in 1838 and was eight and a half years old when her father died. Life in Upper Canada was still quite primitive at that time, but for a family to lose a parent was cause for even more hardship.

Barbara's mother married again to Christian Riser, and they moved north and west of the old settlement into what was known as the "Queen's Bush." This was a clergy reserve not open officially to settlers until the 1850s, although people were moving in already in the 1840s. Barbara, her older sister and youngest brother were with their mother and step-father in the 1851 census, while the other children probably worked for their board in other homes. Until 1852 the family lived in a shanty; so life could not have been very comfortable. Barbara's mother gave birth to five more children, three of whom grew to maturity.

In 1860, Barbara married Jacob Schweitzer, a young man who had come from France with his parents, Joseph and Catherine Schweitzer. In 1851 Jacob, age 17, was a laborer in the home of Christian and Catherine Roth in Wilmot. Christian B. Jantzi (Barbara's brother) also happened to be living in that home, and, no doubt, Jacob and Barbara learned to know each other through this contact.

Barbara and Jacob moved into Morningson Township, Perth County (Lot #17, Con.I).¹ This farm was located just west of the Jantzi-Riser home and one road south. The little settlement here, where several townships meet, was called Topping. Here were born their ten or eleven children. There may have been an infant son of whom we have found no record.

In 1880, Jacob and Barbara's oldest daughter Catherine was married to Andrew Nafziger. That same year the whole Schweitzer family moved to Milford, Nebraska. John Nafziger (Andrew's son) thinks they lived about four miles from Milford. Barbara's brother Joseph B. Jantzi had already come one or two years previously. Barbara's sister Maria Ulrich and her brother Christian and their families probably arrived the previous year.

By the time the Schweitzers and Nafzigers arrived, the Amish Mennonite Congregation had already built a meetinghouse at the present East Fairview location. Life in the new settlement continued to bring its hardships. In 1881 and 1883 Barbara and Jacob lost their two youngest daughters. Barbara's brother, Joseph B. Jantzi, also died in 1881.

About 1883, the Schweitzers and Nafzigers moved to Holt County. In 1887, Mary, who had married a young Canadian, Samuel Axt, died, only a year after her marriage, and is buried in the Mennonite cemetery north of O'Neill. In 1893, Andrew and Catherine Nafziger returned to Ontario,

Canada. Jacob and Barbara and the rest of their children returned, probably at different times, to Milford. Jacob died in 1899 and Barbara in 1915. They are buried in the East Fairview Mennonite cemetery south of Milford.

Barbara's granddaughter, Ida (Schweitzer, Stutzman) Roth remembered her grandmother Barbara (Jantzi) Schweitzer and shared her memories:

"I was about seven years old when we lived in Milford, Nebraska. At the time, Grandma lived with Uncle Mose and Aunt Lovina across the road from us.

I do not remember too much about her, because we children were not allowed to cross the road, and she very seldom came to visit us. She was a very serious-minded and unfriendly person, it seemed to me as a child.

She loved being out in the garden. We could see her working in her black dress and apron. She was always dressed black. She loved flowers, especially petunias of which she raised a lot.

She made her own house slippers with old overall material. She would stitch the sole and pad it together until it was stiff, then would sew the top part on. They looked very comfortable to me.

She also worked with bees. When a swarm of bees landed any place, she would cover herself with net and smoke them out and put them in a box. Later they would take the honey from the box for their own use on the table.

I remember as plain as yesterday what her room looked like. She had a big wood heater, and during the winter Mose would keep it going for her. She also had a big wooden bedstead, a chest of drawers and a big heavy clothes closet. She lived in this room but ate her meals with Mose and Lovina.

She was also busy with her hands. She knit a bedspread for each of her children. I was the fortunate one to inherit the one my father had. It is approximately 75 years old. I have it on my bed every day. It is coming apart in a few places. I would love to launder it, but I'm afraid it would completely fall apart.

We moved to Wood River, Nebraska, a few years later. We just barely got there, and we had a call from Milford that Grandma had passed away. My father turned around and went right back again. The rest of us stayed at home."

THE JOSEPH SCHWEITZER FAMILY

We have a rather sketchy knowledge of the Schweitzer family to which Jacob Schweitzer, husband of Barbara Jantzi, belonged. The information we have has been pieced together from census records, bishop's records of marriages and births, and several individual family records.

The earliest documentation of the family in Canada is that found in the 1851 census. Joseph and Catherine, ages 60 and 48 respectively, were living in Wilmot Township. On the chart below, this Joseph and Catherine are found in the left column. The family was listed next to the widow of Christian Boshart in the census.

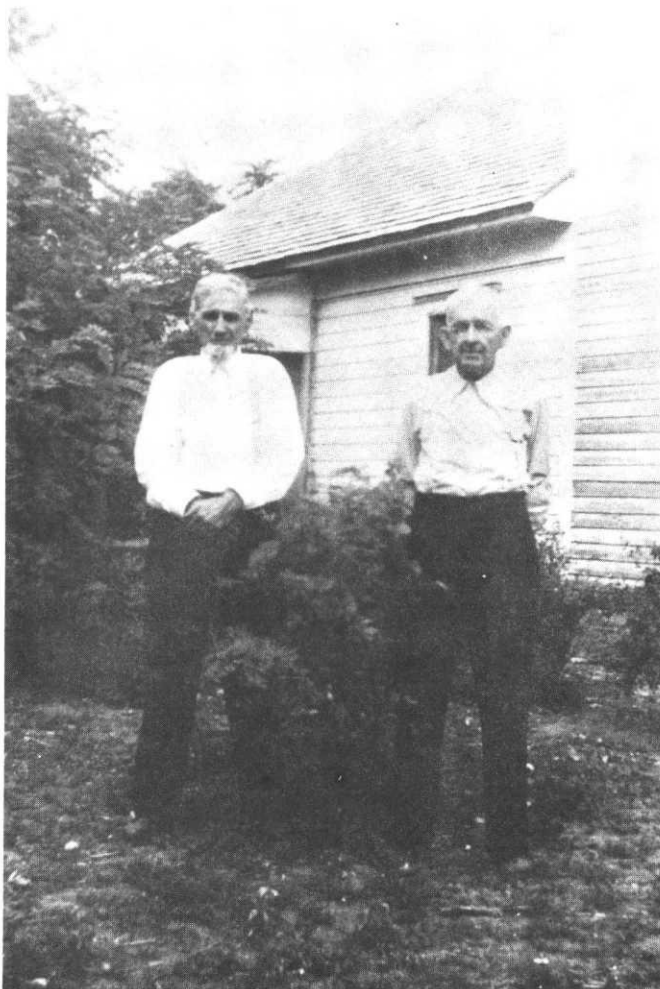

CATHERINE SCHWEITZER AND ANDREW NAFZIGER FAMILY

Catherine Schweitzer was the second child of Barbara Jantzi and Jacob Schweitzer, but the oldest to survive. Her older brother John died in infancy. Catherine grew up on the family farm in Mornington Township, Perth County, near the hamlet of Topping.

Catherine married Andrew Nafziger in May of 1880. He was the son of Samuel Nafziger and Anna Kipfer. Grandson John Nafziger claims that their honeymoon was the move of the entire Jacob Schweitzer family to Milford, Nebraska.

In December of 1883 someone wrote a letter from Holt County, Nebraska reporting that "Jacob Schweitzer and Andreas Nafziger are hoping to come." John thinks Christian Schweitzer also went to Holt Co. Here they herded cattle. The lack of rainfall and the sandy soil makes this area unsuitable for farming. The Nafzigers

built their sod house about five miles south and east of O'Neill. However, during eight of the ten years the Nafzigers were here there was no rain. John remembers them telling about the sunny days and sitting around at night and singing.

In 1893 the Nafzigers and their two children, Elia and Ezra, went back to Ontario. There were few frontiers left, but they found Lot #11, Con. XV in Ellice Township still covered with trees. This is about one mile south of Brunner. Some wild animals were still around. John remembers that a wild cat ran up a tree, pounced on their dog, but his mother happened to be there with a pitch fork and killed it.

Catherine and Andrew were members of the Mornington Amish Mennonite Congregation and are buried in the cemetery adjoining the meetinghouse about a mile west of Poole.
