G.g. f. built his home on the next plantation to Thomas Jefferson.

The earliest settlement was made in Ill. in 1680, & 4 yrs. afterward, the Mississippi having been discovered by De Sol's, the French took formal possession of the valley of the Mississippi, & in honor of Louis, king of France, named it Louisiana, soon after that event this country began to be called Illinois Country, after a powerful tribe of Indians by that name, &c

In 1763, by a treaty between England & France, this country became an English province & remained as such until it was surrendered to the U. S. by the John Jay treaty in 1796.

After the formal surrender of the N. W. Territory to the U. S. it was divided into 5 counties. The portion of the territory in which Williamson Co. is embraced belonged to St. Clair Co. with Kaskaskia as Co. seat & remained until 1809 when Illinois was organized into a Territory proper. In laying out the counties, the portion which had been part of St. Clair Co. now fell into Gallatin Co. where it belonged until Illinois was admitted to Union in 1818 and Franklin Co. was taken off the west side of Gallatin Co. In 1818/1839

Franklin Co. was divided and the southern half called Williamson Co. The surface of the Co. is level with the exception of some rough land along its south side. When our fathers came here

they found these virgin plains unclaimed, with grass higher than their heads and for 20 yrs it was the best range man ever saw until the farmers stopped the hunters from burning the woods.

In the early days the prairies and woodlands were filled with wild animals.
