Item 2nd - It is my will that after my decease all my property both personal and real shall remain in the possession of my beloved wife Maria Sarge (should she survive me) during her life time and it is my will that she shall receive the entire proceeds of said property but that no part of my real estate shall be sold or conveyed by her.

Item 3rd - It is my will that; on the death of my wife all my property shall be equally divided among my child ren except that the amount of One Thousand Dollars heretofore advanced to my son George Sarge One Thousand Dollars heretofore advanced to my son Phillimer Sarge and Five Hundred Dollars heretofore advanced to each of my daughters Ann Eliza M. S. & Fee and Rachel E. Denton shall be deducted

from their respective Shares from the final
division of my estate among my children.
