Dear Kenneth and Mary Ann;

Thank you for taking the time to spend with me last month when I was in Illinois. It was really nice to visit with you again. I look forward to seeing you again, but it will be down here in Florida since we have now moved back to Sarasota. When you come down this fall we would be happy to have you stop and see us. We are only 2 miles off I-75 at Exit # 39. I can give you directions at that time. Or if you call I can give you directions on the phone.

The day after I was at your home I decided to drive out to Pike County, Illinois. It made it simple after you looked on the map and found where "Pike County" was. Took me about one hour and a half to drive it. I went to Pittsfield, the county seat, to their library and successfully found cemetery records listing where Elijah and Sarah Hill Cole are buried in the Yates-Hinman cemetery. Also, found the record of marriage license of Samuel Cole and Mary Maguire. I talked with the librarian and she knew where that cemetery is. I, also, found the marriage license record of Rice Medaris and Rozannah Cole.

After getting directions to the cemetery, by way of a local map, I drove out to it. W-a-a-y out in the middle of nowhere. No houses within miles, only hay fields, soybean and corn fields. I drove across little one lane bridges, dodged downed trees, and put up with lots of dust driving over a gravel road for more than five miles! But, it was rewarding, interesting and productive as well. The cemetery dates to 1847 and is being used even today. It comprises 2 acres of land and is fairly well maintained within a fence. All of the headstones are repaired when fallen over or broken, and someone mows it on a regular schedule. It is located 3 and a half miles west of Griggsville and then north about 3 miles on the gravel county line road. It is southwest of Perry, Illinois. Elijah Cole lived in Fairmount Township which is right next to the cemetery. The cemetery is located in Section 6 of Griggsville Township. Kenneth your father, Ben Cole, was born in the Fairmount Township. So must have been born while they lived there prior to moving to Bement.

In the cemetery I found eight headstones for the family. There may have been more but that is all that I found. Your ^{great} grandparents, Elijah and Sarah (Hill) Cole are both buried there and the headstones are readable. Elijah is spelled "Eligah" on his headstone. Rozannah Cole Medaris is buried there having died two months after their marriage at the age of 18. Next to her there is an infant of R. Medaris buried there. But I can't read initial of mother so don't know if it is Rice and Mary's child or not. So Rice Medaris then must have married her younger sister because Mary Cole Medaris and Rice Medaris are both buried in the family plot in Monticello cemetery along with two of their daughters.

Also, buried in Hinman cemetery are daughters of Elijah and Sarah Cole named Nancy Cole b. Feb. 5, 1825 and d. 17 Oct. 1841 and Sarah Cole b. 8 Oct. 1832 d. 5 Aug. 1846. There is a toddler named James B. Cole b. 6 Oct. 1866 aged 1 yr. 3 mo 10 da. the son of J.S. and S.W. Cole. Buried in the same family plot is Ann wife of B.R. Cole d. Oct. 14, 1862.

Jim Lichtenberg, cousin from Kansas was at the Mormon genealogy library just recently and he thinks Elijah Cole was married again in 1864 to a Corinth-Stoddard. His wife Sarah (Hill) Cole had died in 1863 so it is possible. Jim has sent for the microfilm to check this out for us.

I am enclosing two computer printout genealogy sheets for you. 1st. printing was in July and I had that with me at your house. Was my "work sheet" for that trip. The 2nd. printing is last one Jim did and I just received it. Printed in information is some of what I was able to learn on that trip and had not given to Jim yet. There may be some mistakes in the information so if there is please correct it back to me so we can get it correct on the record.

As you can see we need more information on the two of you and your offspring. So the questions for you are:

- 1. Mary Ann where were you born: Twp., County, State*
- 2. Kenneth where were you born: Twp., County, State*
- 3. Where were you married: Twp., County, State*
- 4. Children of yours: Name, born, died, in Twp., County, State.*
- 5. Spouse's of children: same information Twp., County, State*
- 6. Grandchildren: Name, born, died, in Twp., County, State*
- 7. Kenneth were you married prior to Mary Ann? If so need that information with names, dates and any children information.*
- 8. Maude Weaver Cole, where was she born: Twp, County, State.*
- 9. Maude Cole and Ben Cole, when and where were they married: Twp., County, State.*

I think those are all of the questions that Jim asked for in his last letter. So I will close for this time and wait for your answers to these questions. If you see, or know of anything else that should be included please let us know. I didn't try to contact Duane Medaris while I was there; I wish I had but perhaps you could contact him and find out where he fits into the family. Perhaps he would know how the "Lux" family fits in, also. I would like to have Duane's address in Bement if you have it, too.

Until I hear from you know that I wish you both health and happiness and am eternally grateful for all the knowledge you have given to us. I would love to meet your son if he brings you down this fall. I remain,

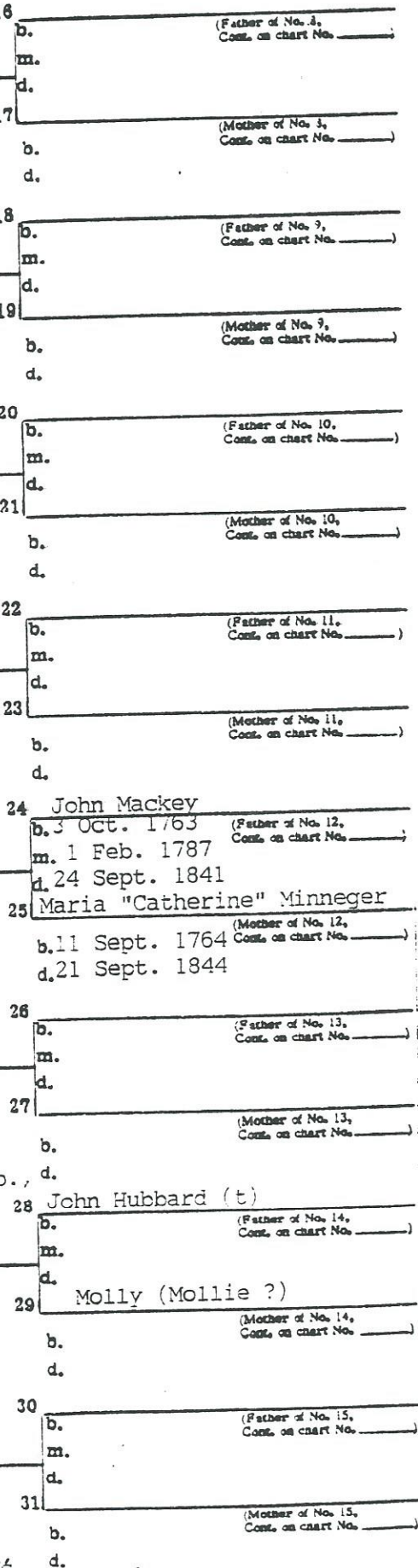
