Good morning. I finally got back over to the old Cole cemetery yesterday and took some photos for you. It was a really nice day here yesterday and great weather to get out. I tried to get access to the cemetery a couple weeks ago but there was no one readily available to let me in at the time. Unfortunately it's a bit of a hassle now to get access to the cemetery as the property is now completely fenced in with a security gate. There is a phone number at the gate and I had to call a foreman there at the water plant to let me in.. He told me this gate is now in place for security and safety reasons to prevent anyone from getting unauthorized access to the grounds. At any rate he advised me anytime family wants to visit they will give access.

I took individual photos for you of all the monuments, hopefully you can make out all the inscriptions. The stones all face out west and it would probably have been better to have visited in the afternoon for better light conditions. Just let me know if you receive these all ok. I will also send a follow up email with photos I took just outside the cemetery wall and the old Cole property surrounding the water treatment grounds.
